*** A North Cumberland WMA OHV Permit is required for OHV use on all trails in the North Cumberland Wildlife Management Area. A permit is required for all OHV occupants aged 13 or older. Annual Sportsman and Lifetime License holders are exempt from OHV permit requirements. A guide license is required if an individual accepts compensation for providing assistance to another in OHV use while utilizing the North Cumberland trail system. Annual Sportsman and Lifetime License holders are not exempt from Guide License requirements.

No resident of Tennessee shall be required to possess any of the permits listed above when hunting on the 4th Saturday in August, known as free hunting day. Hunting is limited to those species on which there is an open season as proclaimed by the Tennessee Fish & Wildlife Commission.
